**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION** Develop your interviewing skills by focusing on four crucial areas: a) “know thyself,” b) your personal pitch (aka the “elevator speech”), c) impromptu interview questions, and d) mock interviews. This Career Chat, presented in conjunction with the Career Advocacy Group, will help sharpen your skills in all four areas by simulating a high-pressure interview environment in which you will obtain instant, positive, strategic feedback from other participants and the moderators. Instead of “performing” for one person you will present yourself to your peers, a mock hiring manager, and a small evaluation/feedback team. This method dramatically increases preparedness through repetition of themes in your selling message, and through depth and breadth of feedback.
